Instructor will provide the cold wax, paper, powdered pigment, charcoal and some transparent oils.

Students will provide: Assortment of oil paints *, 4" rubber brayer, Latex /nitrile gloves, Odorless solvent and container to hold it, Couple of palette knives, 12" X 16" palette paper or freezer paper, Squeegee** or anything to move paint around. (Old hotel keys, plastic coated cards work very well), Paper towels or rags for cleanup - process messy, Painters tape, anything to make impressions in the paint - tissue paper, wooden skewers, combs, wax paper, etc.

Material specifics:

*Oil paints - Bring a variety of transparent and opaque, lights and darks in your favorite colors, to include white and either burnt or raw umber. Tubes are well marked as to where transparent or opaque. I will have a variety of transparents for you to try should you not have any.

**Dough scrapper - This is my primary tool. I use the MESSERMEISTER Silicone Bowl Scraper (\$10.00) from Amazon. This brand provides the necessary smoothness and flexibility some others do not.
